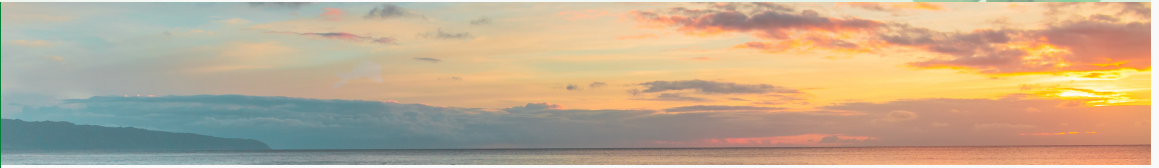

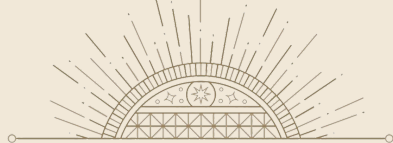

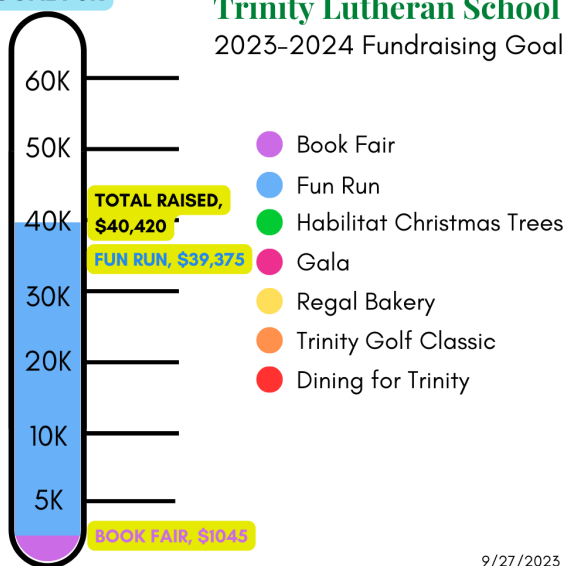
FUNDRAISING
