Exclusive Early Enrollment is officially open through January 13, 2023. This will be Trinity's 70th year and we look forward to celebrating this milestone with you! Enrollment forms are available online only. All families, whether returning or not, are asked to complete the online enrollment form.

Current Trinity Lutheran Church & School members are invited to enroll during the Exclusive Early Enrollment (EEE) period, December 2, 2022-January 13, 2023. During this time, the discounted enrollment fee is \$200 per student. Completing the EEE form and payment secures your child's spot in their class next school year. Please note, the enrollment fee increases to \$500 per student once Open Enrollment begins on January 14, 2023.

This year we have several large classes, a couple of which hold students on a waitlist. Seats are filled on a first come, first paid basis. We cannot guarantee returning students will have a spot once Open Enrollment begins.

Families who plan to apply for financial aid, must be enrolled for the 2022-2023 school

year and have their accounts up to date, before their financial aid application will be considered.

DRIVE WITH ALOHA

We have received concerns from our neighbors that we are driving too fast through the back streets. Remember the speed limit is 15mph. Please drive with caution when coming to and leaving our campus. STUDENT ABSENCE REPORTING

All absences, including tardies of 15+ minutes must be reported through the attendance line. Please call 808-621-6033 ext. 9. Leave a message stating the student's name,

grade, and reason for absence/tardy. You may also send an email to office@tls-hawaii.org, in lieu of leaving a voice message.

If you need to pick up your child/ren earlier than school dismissal time, please notify the office before 9am. This allows time for the office and teacher to have your child/ren ready with minimal disruption to the class.

DROP-OFF & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

PRESCHOOL & PRE-KINDERGARTEN

Preschool (PS) & Pre-Kindergarten (PK) students must be signed in & out at their classroom. Parents must park on the back lawn or court off of Ho'olulu Road for morning drop-off (and pick-up for full day students). Parents picking up half-day students may park in the front parking lot off of California Avenue. The parking stalls facing California Avenue are reserved for parent/guest use.

*The gate to the back lawn/court will open from 715am-8am for drop-off and 215pm-3pm (115pm-2pm on Wednesdays) for pick-up. If you are dropping off and picking up outside of these times, please use the front parking lot.

KINDERGARTEN-8TH GRADE

Kindergarten through 8th grade students are invited to use drive-thru service in the front parking lot. We ask that parents do not park. Cars should be entering and exiting the parking lot in one direction to keep students safe. In the morning, a staff member will be monitoring drop-off. At dismissal, students will be escorted to their cars by a teacher. Please do not get out of your car. This helps to keep the traffic moving. We do not want to create a backlog of traffic.

If you prefer to park, please follow the above procedures for PS & PK families.
