We utilize a combination of the ABEKA ABC-123, One in Christ Bible Curriculum, and Scholastic My Big World, along with our own Kindergarten preparatory curriculum to support early childhood development.

## **Spiritual Growth**

Our number one mission is to instill a love for God in each of our students. We do this by:

- Sharing Bible stories
- Participating in daily devotions and prayers
- Attending chapel
- Modeling Christian love through our personal witness

Children are reminded daily that they are deeply loved by God and uniquely created with purpose.
