TRAVEL POLICY

We are very thankful for the families that have informed us of their out of state travel &/or out of town visitors who are staying in their households. Our COVID Handbook states that unvaccinated students must quarantine for 10 days if any household member or visitor has traveled outside the State of Hawaii. To bypass a student needing to quarantine; we would need either a negative COVID test or a copy of the traveler's COVID vaccination card. This information should be reported to the Office Manager.
